NOTIFICATION OF STAKEHOLDER WORKSHOPS: LISTING OF PUBLIC LAUNCH SITES IN KWAZULU-NATAL

The KZN Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs (EDTEA) has embarked on a process of listing public launch sites in the province in terms of section 2(1) of the 'Management of Public Launch Sites in the Coastal Zone Regulations' (Government Gazette No. 37761).

A "public launch site" means a site where a vessel may be launched by members of the public in the coastal zone, but **excludes those sites in protected areas and in proclaimed harbours.**
