

The Shipping and Transport College – Southern Africa (STC) is engaging in a Funding initiative in collaboration with the Maritime Seta, Transport Education & Training Authority (TETA) to support and develop HET students within Marine Studies towards their Research Projects/Internship within Marine Studies qualifications.

Please find that the letters/documents which are required to be included as supporting documents should your candidates intend to join the Project:

- (a) Copy of Workplace Agreement from the Marine Studies Department as the Host Workplacement Department where the internship will be taking place indicating that the Intern will be placed for a period of 12 months;
- (b) Letter from the respective Academic Institution, stating that the internship is a requirement for completion of qualification and stating the duration of placement required;

The other additional documents required are:

- (c) Certified Copy of the candidate's ID;
- (d) A copy of your CV
- (e) Certified copies of your academic certificates

STC-SA have 24 free seats available for this Project. STC-SA will then compile an Implementation Plan per the availability of the candidates.

Our intended start date for this Project is before 31 March 2018 until 31 March 2019. Those beneficiaries who intend to participate must forward their relevant information STC-SA as soon as possible as the Project closes 9 March 2018.

**Stipend allowance:**

The allowance is calculated at R3 337,50 per month for a period of 12 months only.

To qualify for the Stipend the Intern is required to remain within the Workplace and being offered opportunities to serve onboard Research Vessels at times over this period.
